NULCA location guidelines

This two (2) day short course on underground asset location is designed for telecommunication workers who install, maintain or work near underground services. Learn to use a variety of techniques to locate underground assets such as cables, gas lines, plumbing or electricity to prevent damage and to work safely.

The mission of NULCA (National Utility Locating Contractors Association) is to define, establish and maintain best work practices performed by the underground utility locating industry.

This course provides learners the opportunity to establish work standard and competencies which will assist in providing a safer work environment for the general public, excavators, and all people in the civil works and underground service locating industry. Learners will gain the skills to accurately locate, mark and avoid damaging buried underground assets using industry standard techniques such as the Dial Before You Dig service, electromagnetic locating, ground penetrating radar (GPR) and handheld devices as well as occupational health and safety training, instruction and information.
