On an unrelated subject Otre, can you please advise what procedures are in place for the installation of Trace Wires when Fibre Optic Cables are installed by Contractors on behalf of Telstra. Further what steps are taken by Telstra to ensure that the trace wire is serviceable when installed along its entire length. Also if Nulca members find that these trace wire installations are defective what course of action is available in regard to reporting this to Telstra.

If there is no mechanism in place to ensure the serviceability of these installations can I suggest that Nulca members can provide a simple and independent assessment of the suitability of the trace wire for a modest fee.
